

Patients whole repeat list that can be inactivated.

This search will find all those patients whereby none of their repeat medication has been issued in the last 15 months.

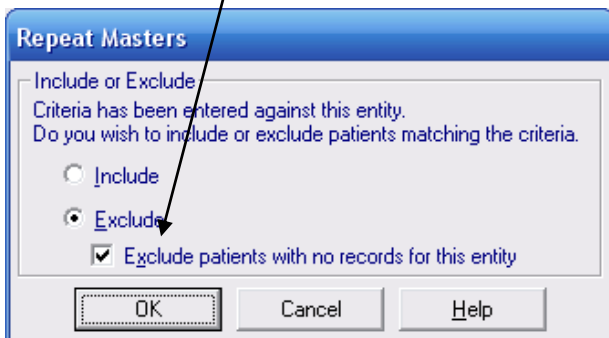
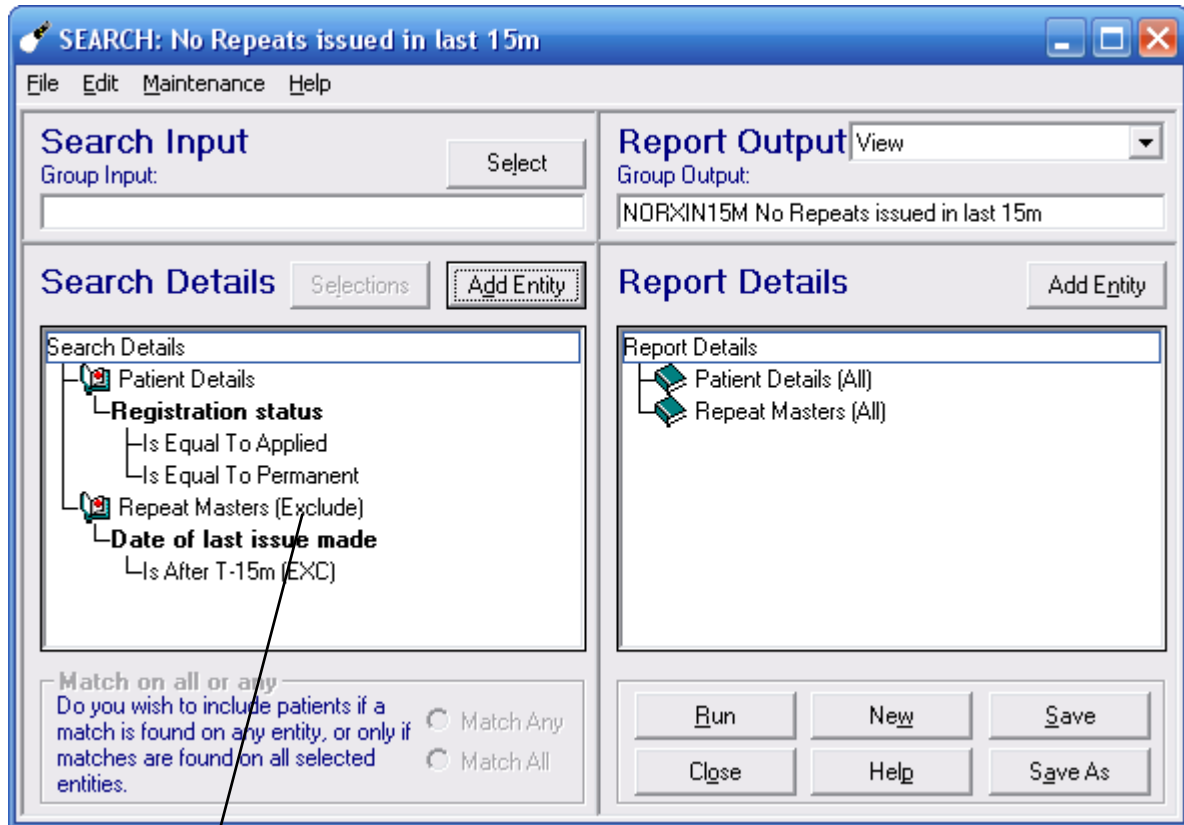
Which means that you won't have to do any medication reviews for any of these patients and it will immediately increase your QOF percentage figures and leave you with an accurate list of patients who do need a medication review.

You will need to build two searches:

1. Exclude patients who have had an repeat issued in the last 15 months
2. Only show active repeats authorised over 6 months ago.

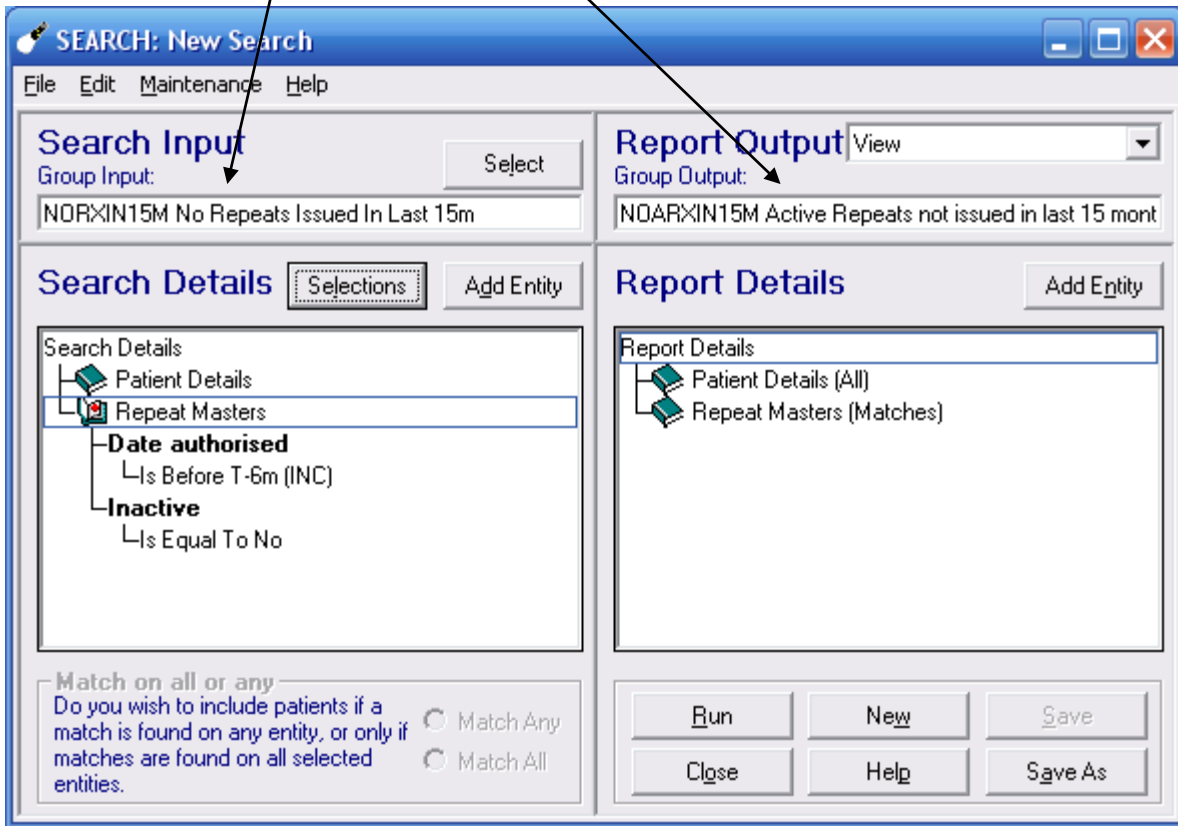
Note: you cannot not use active repeats and exclude in the same search, and the authorised element doesn't include patients' that have just been put on a repeat in the last 6 months and maybe awaiting their first issue.

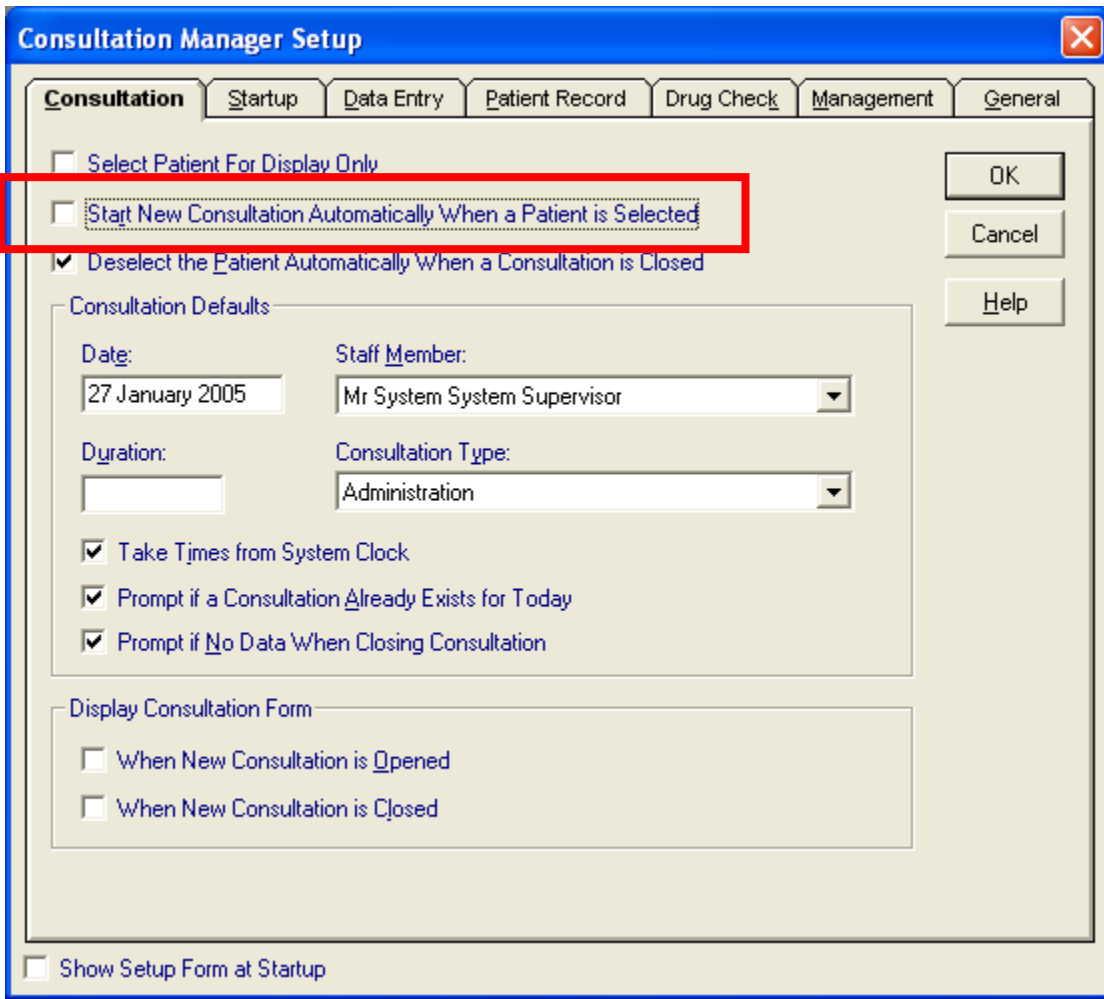
Input 1st group search and create an Output Group as your final list of patients.



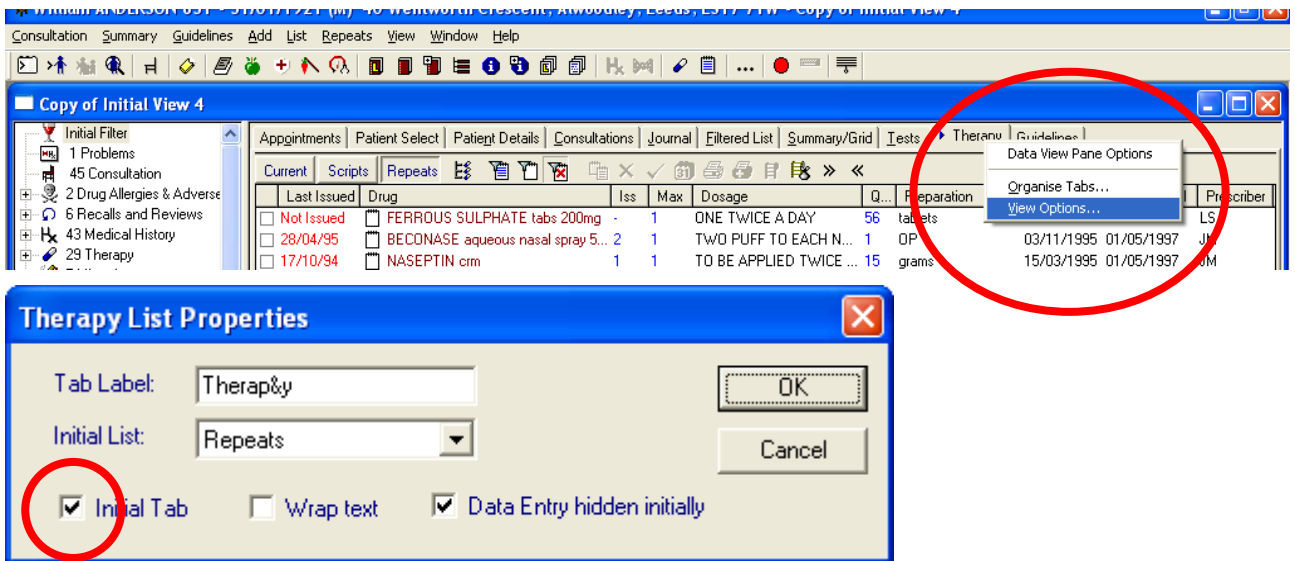
Now open Consultation Manager

You may want to temporarily amend your consultation screen so that it doesn't start a consultation and set the Repeat Therapy screen to show first.

Consultation menu > Options > Setup

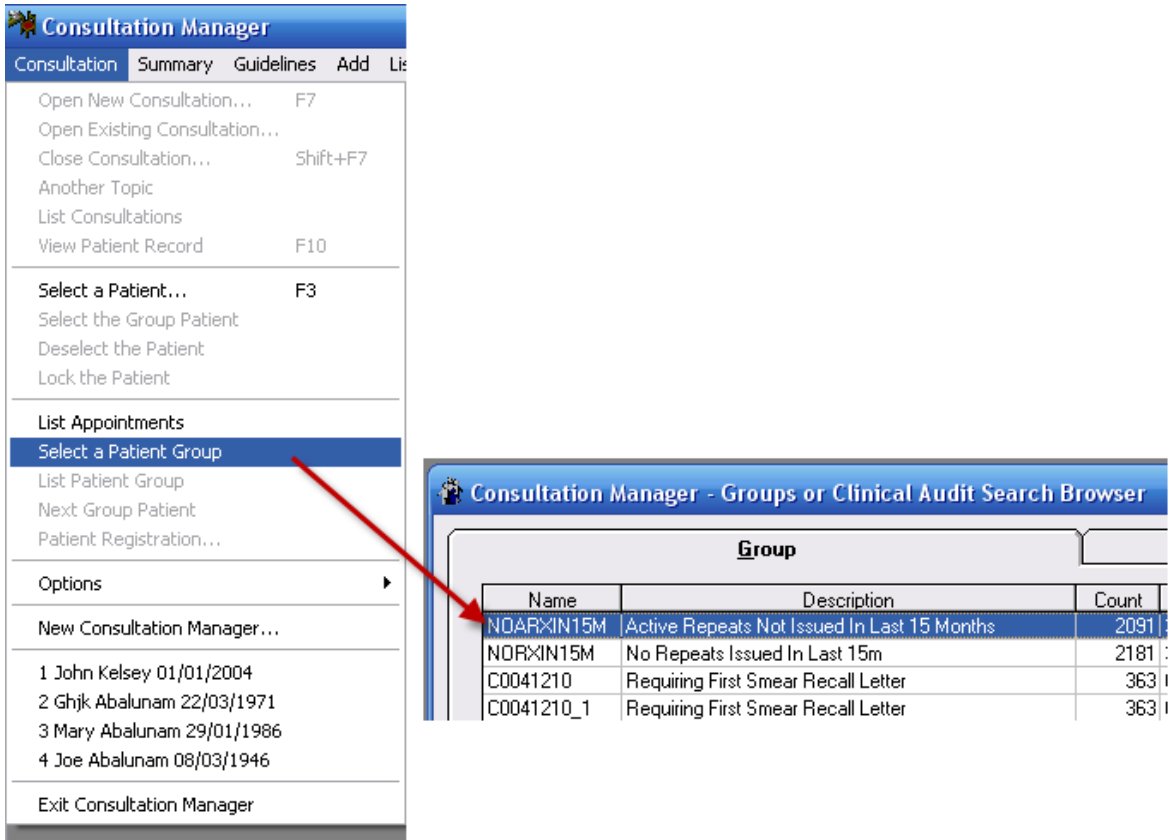


Temporarily make the Repeat Therapy screen your default.

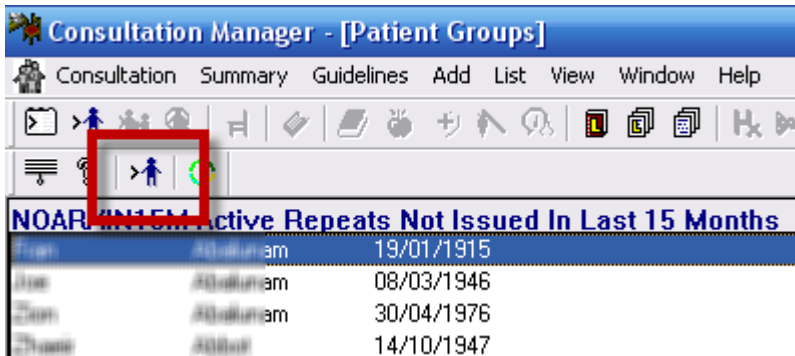


Now to start inactivating the repeat masters

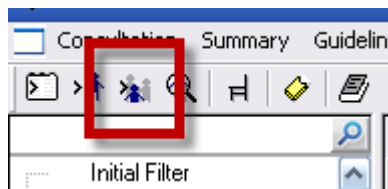
1. Click the Consultation menu > Select a Patient Group



2. Locate your saved group and double click it to list the patients
3. Highlight the 1st patient in the list and click the LOWER little blue patient button to open the patient record.



4. Inactivate the repeat/s and then click the Next Group Patient button



5. You may also want to delete the DUE medication review. Please DO NOT delete medication reviews that have a complete date.
